POLICE MOTOR TRAINING SEMINAR SEPTEMBER 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>

The 2018 “Bikes on the Bricks Police Motorcycle Training Seminar” is being held on September 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>. This year marks our 12<sup>th</sup> Anniversary for an event that has become well known throughout the United States and Canada. Motor training and course practice will held on the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> with the main riding event held on Sunday the 9<sup>th</sup>. Motor Officers are encouraged to attend all three days.

Once again this year there will be three categories for motor officers, those being: **Novice, Expert** and the **Over Fifty** category which will replace the Retired class. If you sign up in the over fifty age group you will be considered an expert vying for the Gravel Master award (Old Retired).

For those of you that have not attended this training event in the past, the Police Motor Training Seminar is held on two large parking lots in the center of Downtown Flint, next to the University of Michigan-Flint campus. What makes this training event so unique is it is held in conjunction with a family oriented civilian motorcycle show held throughout the downtown area on both Saturday and Sunday. This event draws several thousands of spectators which line the parking lots to watch their favorite Motor units practice their slow riding skills. This provides a great opportunity for officers to interact with the public in ways they never have.
