POLICE MOTOR TRAINING SEMINAR SEPTEMBER 11TH, 12TH, AND 13TH, 2026

The 2026 “Bikes on the Bricks Police Motorcycle Training Seminar” is being held on September 11th, 12th, and 13th. This year marks our 19th Anniversary for an event that has become well known throughout the United States and Canada. Motor training and course practice will be held on the 11th and 12th with the main riding event held on Sunday the 13th. Motor Officers are encouraged to attend all three days.

This year there will be four categories for motor officers, those being: **Novice, Expert, Over Fifty** and **Elite**. If you sign up in the **Over Fifty** age group you will be considered an expert vying for the Gravel Master award (Old Retired). This year’s new category, **Elite**, is for any motor officer that has previously won the overall “King Of The Bricks”. **If you have won the overall “King Of The Bricks” you MUST register under the ELITE category.**

For those of you that have not attended this training event in the past, the Police Motor Training Seminar is held on two large parking lots in the center of Downtown Flint, next to the University of Michigan-Flint campus. What makes this training event so unique is it is held in conjunction with a family oriented civilian motorcycle show held throughout the downtown area on both Saturday and Sunday. This event draws several thousands of spectators which line the parking lots to watch their favorite Motor units practice their slow riding skills. This provides a great opportunity for officers to interact with the public in ways they never have.

This being our 19th Anniversary, we have increased the number of allowed motor officers attending to the first 100 Motor Officers to register online. The online registration and lodging can be found at www.BikesontheBricks.com. Once again, this year, the courses **will not** be released until the welcoming breakfast the morning of the 11th.

The cost for this year’s event is again “Free” thanks in part to our great local sponsors and community support.
